



Adopt-A-Missionary

Purpose

Our church body serves as senders when we send out missionaries to different parts of the world. We want to adopt these missionaries for 3 purposes:

- Give them ongoing prayer & moral support.
- Gain greater accountability with our missionaries.
- Be blessed from seeing and hearing what God is doing in the mission field.

Missionary Adoption Team (MAT)

A missionary adoption team consists of at least 2-3 *Adopters* (individuals and/or families) who adopt a specific missionary. One of the Adopters should serve as the *Coordinator* for the team.

Eligibility

- Anyone who is in Jr. High or above can join.
- Commit to fulfill an Adopter's responsibilities.

MAT Coordinator's Responsibilities

- Ensure the team is in regular communication with and praying for their missionary.
- Serve as liaison between the adopters, Missions Dept. & the congregation.
- Prepare scheduled written or verbal updates about their missionaries.

Adopter's Responsibilities

- Learn about the adopted missionary & his/her mission work.
- Keep up with the current, specific details of his/her life and ministry.
- Actively pray for the adopted missionary.
- Bond with adopted missionary through letters, email, etc.
- Notify your coordinator about your adopted missionary's special needs.
- Meet with missionary while he/she is on furlough.

Term of Commitment

- One year.

Adopted Missionary's Responsibilities to CBCSJ & Adopters

- Pray regularly for his/her adopters.
- Provide updates to the adopters through regular newsletter/prayer letter.
- Visit in person whenever possible.
