The Grand Prix is a special AWANA event in which clubbers design cars created by themselves or with the help of a parent. There will be a Racing Division competition and an Artistic (non-racing) Design Division competition. Participants will receive a "Photo ID Grand Prix Pass" and "Car Number Sticker". Please invite your friends to participate or watch!

The Racing track will be available beginning Friday, Sept 30th (the location will be announced at opening ceremony) for practice and car tune-ups on Friday nights (before and after AWANA) and Sundays after 12:30pm.

General Instructions & Specifications

- Materials that can be used: Legos, K'Nexs, Duplos, Mega Bloks, etc...
- Plastic parts only. No metallic components. A metal detector will be used on the day of the race.
- Each clubber may enter 1 car for the Racing Division and/or 1 car for the Artistic Design Division
- See reverse side for additional information.

If you want to participate and do not have any lego or plastic building blocks, simple and inexpensive car kits are available at Walgreens, Big Lots, ToysRUs, or at the Lego Store in Valley Fair. The Lego Store in Valley Fair also have pieces which you can choose and buy by the bucket. Note: the small wheels (9/16" diameter) sold at the Lego store is not as good for racing, but fine for the artistic design. If you have Legos but no wheels, please see Sam Lee and buy 4 large (1-1/16"D) wheels and axles at cost for \$1.50.

Additional information

Awards for both the "Racing" and "Artistic Design" Divisions

- One Champion Trophy for "Racing" and one Champion Trophy for "Artistic Design"
- 1st & 2nd Place Ribbons per Qualifier group.
- The four Qualifier groups are Cubbies-SparksK, Sparks 1st 2nd, T&T 3rd 4th and T&T 5th 6th. If participation is low, we may combine some of the groups.

Racing Division

Judging Criteria

- Winner will be determined either by the race finish order OR, if no one crosses the finish line, the car closest to the finish line. If the car breaks apart, your mark will be set to the part closest to the start line.
- Best out of 3 races.

Additional Requirements

- No weight or height limit.
- Must have at least 3 wheels and wheels must touch the track at the starting gate.
- Maximum wheel diameter is 1.25 inches.
- Maximum length is 6 inches.

Things to consider

- The track is a 2" radius semicircle and 10ft long. The air thrust nozzle is located 2.25" from the bottom of the track.
- Increasing the area where the air is blown captures more thrust (forward push).
- Increasing the width and height without aerodynamics considerations adds air friction. Friction slows down the car.
- The position of the wheels is also important.

Artistic Design Division

Judging Criteria

1. Theme: "Rise Up! Proclaim the Good News!"
 2. Originality and Creativity
 3. Color or Pattern Artistic Design
- Judging will be performed by adults who are not parents of the Clubbers being judged.
 - Judging for all groups will be held on Friday November 4th, starting at 9:30pm.

Additional Requirements

- There is no weight, height, width, or length requirement.
- It has to have wheels and move like a car. Note: It does not need to actually look like a typical car. For example, it could be a house or platform on wheels with people on it. It just has to roll and to move like a car.
